NORTHEAST OVERVIEW

The BTO NY team is responsible for the business development and management of 14 territories in the Northeastern United States. These territories include Connecticut, Delaware, the District of Columbia, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont, Virginia, and West Virginia.

Together, these states encompass over 181,324 square miles and have a combined estimated population of 55,943,073 according to the 2021 U.S. Census and a 2022 population forecast of 56,574,489. There are approximately 345.5 million people per square mile in the Northeast, making this the most densely populated region in the U.S. The Northeast is one of the most urban areas in the United States. It also leads the nation as the most economically developed and culturally diverse region.

Additionally, the Northeast leads the charge with the largest land area (54,555 sq mi) and population (over 19.45 million people), accounting for the mass YOY arrivals from New York to The Bahamas.
