# WEST COAST OVERVIEW

The BTO-TX team is responsible for the business development and management of the Southwest, Midwest and West Coast/Northwest, United States. There are five (5) key states in the Western region, which include:

- California (CA)
- Nevada (NV)
- Oregon (OR)
- Arizona (AZ)
- Washington (WA)

California is the most populous state in the U.S., with an estimated population of over 39 million people as of 2021. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the state is also one of the most diverse, with a population that is 39% Hispanic, 37% White,15% Asian and 6% Black. In terms of passport ownership, as of 2019, approximately 45% of Californians held a valid U.S. passport. This means that nearly half of the state's population is able to travel internationally, whether for leisure or business purposes.

Nevada, on the other hand, is a much smaller state, with an estimated population of around 3 million people. The state has a high percentage of White residents, with nearly 48% of its population identifying as such, followed by Hispanics at 29%, and African Americans at 10%. As of 2019, around 32% of Nevada's residents held a valid U.S. passport. This percentage is lower compared to California, which may be due to the smaller size of the state and fewer opportunities for international travel.



## WEST COAST OVERVIEW

Oregon is home to over 4 million people, with a population that is 78% White, 13% Hispanic, 5% Asian and 2% Black. As of 2019, around 46% of Oregon's residents held a valid U.S. passport. This percentage is higher than that of Nevada, but lower than California's. The state's natural beauty, including Crater Lake National Park and the Oregon Coast, may be a draw for travellers looking for domestic vacations.

Arizona, with an estimated population of over 7 million people, is also a diverse state, with 32% of its population identifying as Hispanic, 55% as White and 5% as Black. As of 2019, around 36% of Arizona's residents held a valid U.S. passport. This percentage is lower compared to California, but higher than Nevada's. Arizona's tourism industry, which includes attractions such as the Grand Canyon and Sedona, may be a factor in passport ownership.

Washington State, with an estimated population of over 7 million people, has a population that is 70% White, 13% Hispanic, 9% Asian and 4% Black. As of 2019, around 43% of Washington State's residents held a valid U.S. passport. This percentage is higher than Arizona's but lower than California's. Washington's tourism industry, which includes Seattle's Pike Place Market and Mount Rainier National Park, may be a factor in passport ownership.
