The Bahamas welcomes pleasure boaters, charters and bareboat charters throughout the islands, and facilities in Nassau, Grand Bahama Island, The Abacos, The Exuma Cays provide convenient hubs for captains and cruisers. The Association of Bahamas Marinas and Bahamas Port Authority have teamed to offer a new one-stop incentive service to make registration even easier for brokers, charter brokers, boat captains and boat owners. The service provides seamless processing for boat registration, on-line payment of fees, itinerary planning and networking with marinas, hotels, restaurants and destination experiences across The Bahamas' many islands. CHOOSING AN ISLAND THAT 'ROCKS THE BOAT'

The Abacos

Claiming the title as one of the best cruising and sailing destinations in the world, it's no wonder <u>The</u> <u>Abacos</u> are popular amongst boaters. There are 17 marinas throughout the island chain, making it an ideal destination for island hopping from Great Mocco to Green Turtle Cay, Man-O-War Cay and beyond.

Abaco Beach Resort and Boat Harbour – The Bahamas' largest full-service marina is located in Marsh Harbour, equipped with 198 slips, and can accommodate boats up to 200 feet. Shower and laundry facilities, pools and a swim up-bar, a gas and diesel station, yacht maintenance and more are available for guests. <u>www.abacobeachresort.com</u>

Green Turtle Club and Marina – The 40 slip marina offers modern facilities and accommodates vessels up to 130 feet, it has 30/50/100-amp service with water and WIFI access, and full access to the Green Turtle Club Resort, including the yacht club pub, patio and indoor restaurants, pool, restrooms, showers and laundry facilities. <u>www.greenturtleclub.com</u>

Treasure Cay Beach, Marina & Golf Resort– The resort's well protected, full-service marina is complete with a fuel station, dive shop and shower facilities, and equipped with 164 slips; privately-owned vessels are available for charter. <u>www.treasurecay.com/marina</u>



Bluff House Beach Resort & Marina– The resort's marina is equipped with 46 slips and offers shower and laundry facilities, a fuel station and electrical hookups to its guests and accommodates boats of up to 75 feet. <u>www.bluffhouse.com</u>

Leeward Yacht Club Marina Resort – This 24-slip, well-protected marina is nestled within a 7-acre resort. Boaters have access to two shipyards, the restaurant, bar, outdoor pool, tennis courts, and luxury rental homes. <u>www.leewardyachtclub.com</u>

<u>Bimini</u>

<u>Bimini</u>, known as the big game fishing capital of the world. Its location alongside the Gulf Stream makes it fertile fishing ground, home to a number of annual fishing tournaments, and is a popular destination for private power boaters. Full-service marinas are available in North Bimini, South Bimini, Gun Cay and Cat Cay, most offering official ports of entry.

Bimini Big Game Fishing Club – This history-rich hotel offers a full-service marina equipped with 75 slips, accommodates vessels up to 160-feet and offers facilities that cater to the fishing tournaments that take place throughout the year. <u>www.biggameclubbimini.com</u>

Sea Crest Hotel and Marina – The hotel's modern marina can handle yachts up to 100 feet, is equipped with 14 slips, and offers guests freshwater wash-downs, electrical hookups and fish cleaning stations. <u>www.seacrestbimini.com</u>

The Berry Islands

Though a majority of <u>The Berry Islands</u> are uninhabited, they are known as one of the leading ports-ofcall within The Bahamas for cruising pleasure boaters. This tranquil destination is home to a number of caverns and reefs, miles of swim-ashore secluded beaches, and a multitude of harbours – all a big attraction to cruising boaters.

Great Harbour Cay Marina – This marina is located in a serene harbour, equipped with 65 slips, and can accommodate boats up to 130 feet. Amenities include access to the fuel docks shower and laundry facilities, bar and restaurant, and internet. <u>www.greatharbourcaymarina.com</u>

Chub Cay Marina – Located next to "The Billfish Capital of The Bahamas" and within a surge-proof harbour, this full-service marina provides 109 slips, and can accommodate boats up to 190 feet. Boaters can enjoy fine dining at the Harbour House Restaurant and lounge. www.chubcayresortandmarina.com

New Providence – Nassau, Paradise Island

<u>Nassau</u> is the tourism hub of The Bahamas, booming with luxury resorts, fine restaurants, shopping districts, and marinas. This vibrant destination is ideal for island hopping to The Out Islands, including The Berry Islands, Andros, Eleuthera and The Exumas.

The Marina at Atlantis – With direct access from Nassau Harbour, this marina features 63 mega-yacht slips, and can accommodate vessels up to 220 feet. Guests of the marina have access to all of Atlantis' facilities. <u>www.atlantisbahamas.com/rooms/atlantismarina</u>



Bay Street Marina – This 89-slip marina is located in the heart of Nassau and within walking distance of Paradise Island. Boaters with vessels up to 150 feet can dock at Bay Street Marina, and have access to polishing and wash-down services, shower and laundry facilities, the pool and fitness center and more. <u>www.baystreetmarina.com</u>

Nassau Harbour Club Hotel and Marina – The hotel's full service marina is equipped with 65 slips, which can accommodate vessels up to 200 feet. Privately owned vessels are available for charter and fresh water and laundry facilities are on-site. <u>www.nassauharbourclub.com</u>

Albany Marina – This luxury resort community boasts a marina that is truly a yacht haven, accommodating vessels up to 300 feet, with state-of-the-art facilities and world-class amenities. Yacht-goers have access to the fitness center, volleyball and basketball courts. <u>www.albanybahamas.com</u>

Eleuthera and Harbour Island

Located just 50 miles from Nassau are <u>Eleuthera and Harbour Island</u>. Known for their pineapple fields, stunning pink sand beaches, and miles of coastline that attract anglers, boating enthusiasts and surfers.

Romora Bay Resort and Marina – This world-class, full-service marina is located in the heart of Harbour Island and accommodates boats, yachts and mega-yachts up to 190 feet. Valentine's Yacht Club and Marina, Harbour Island – This state-of-the-art marina is the largest yacht marina in Harbour Island, equipped with 51 slips, and accommodates vessels up to 108 feet. Spanish Wells Yacht Haven & Resort – This vibrant resort's 30-slip, all-weather marina is located just off the northwestern tip of Eleuthera and accommodates yachts up to 165 feet. Both airports, which are ports-ofentry with customs and immigration, are located in Rock Sound Eleuthera **(MYER)** and Governor's Harbour, Eleuthera **(MYEM)**. The Exumas

From the pristine white sandy beaches and alluring sapphire water, to the Bahamian rock iguanas and miles of cays and hidden coves, <u>The Exumas</u> are the epitome of Bahamian paradise. Boaters head to this exotic gem of a destination to experience The Bahamas' most prestigious event of the year – the National Family Island Regatta.

Freeport

This unique island is home to the Grand Bahama Sailing Regatta at Taino Beach, attracting boaters from all over the world.

Long Island is one of the most scenic hideaways in The Islands of The Bahamas, with breathtaking cliffs, captivating coral reefs, and serene beaches. The island is divided by the Tropic Of Cancer and is bordered on each side by two contrasting coasts. The western shoreline is composed of soft, white sandy beaches, while the island's east coast consists of rocky bluffs that descend into the sea. The island offers world-class fishing, diving, boating and lush natural beauty.

Flying Fish Marina – This 21-slip marina is nestled in a protective harbor in Clarence Town, a designated Bahamas Port of Entry. Flying Fish Marina is conveniently located for yachters traveling from Florida, and is considered a haven for anglers. Standard amenities include a fuel dock, laundry and shower facilities, and access to internet. <u>www.flyingfishmarina.com</u>
