ARRIVAL:

TESTING REQUIREMENTS

- As of 20 September 2022, the COVID-19 testing requirement for entering The Bahamas has been eliminated.
- All travelers, regardless of vaccination status, are no longer required to submit to pre-travel COVID-19 testing to enter the country.
- Please note: COVID-19 testing is no longer required for persons travelling inter-island (domestic) within The Bahamas, regardless of COVID-19 vaccination status (unvaccinated or fully vaccinated).

DEPARTURE:

- All U.S. residents and green card holders are not required to test.
- Please check your local government guidelines prior to your visit to determine return requirements as some countries may require negative test results for re-entry regardless of vaccination status.

The dock is located 33 miles North of Marsh Harbour and is a 30-minute drive. The ferry service from Treasure Cay to Green Turtle is available daily.

9:00 AM

Depart Treasure Cay for Green Turtle Cay

Green Turtle Cay was one of the first islands settled in The Bahamas, in the 1770s by the Revolutionary War Loyalists. Many of the island's 500 or so residents can trace their ancestry back to these Loyalists.

SUGGESTED TOURS - (Choose 1 of the following tours)

Tour 1: New Plymouth/ Pineapples – (\$22 Per Person Round Trip)

The historic village of New Plymouth on Green Turtle Cay, one of the areas settled by Loyalists in 1783, is named after New Plymouth in Massachusetts. The architectural design of the houses is New England style – tidy, peaked-roofed and brightly and cheerfully painted. It is known for boatbuilding. The residents here were renowned for growing pineapples from 1850 to 1892. Today this industry no longer exists, and New Plymouth is primarily a quaint little fishing village, which makes it very attractive to visitors. *Pineapple's* is located on the harbour directly across from New Plymouth and is easily accessed by golf cart on the Brooklyn Road (in front of The Wrecking Tree) or by boat. It's an open-air, poolside bar overlooking the harbor and Sea of Abaco serving lunch and dinner, and feature delicious conch fritters, grilled fish, and made-to-order conch salad.
